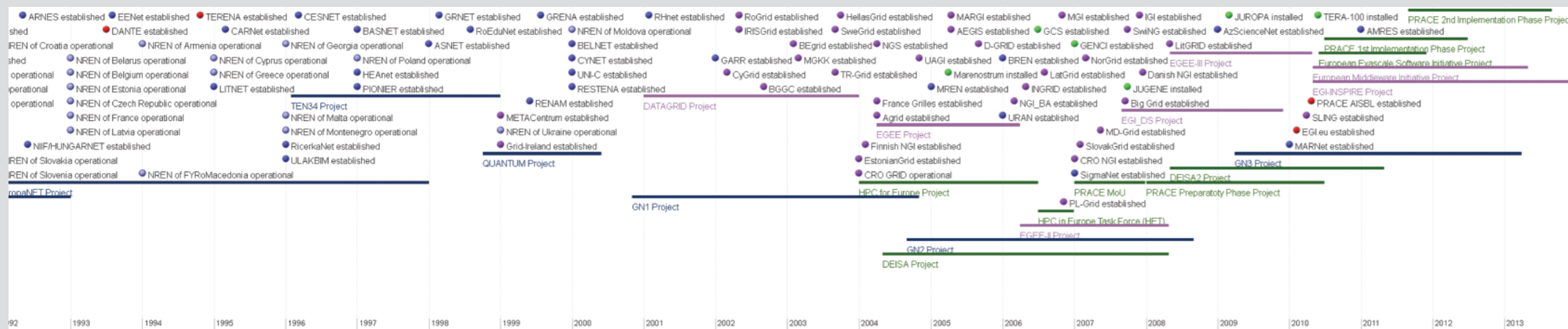

### The European e·Infrastructures Observatory:

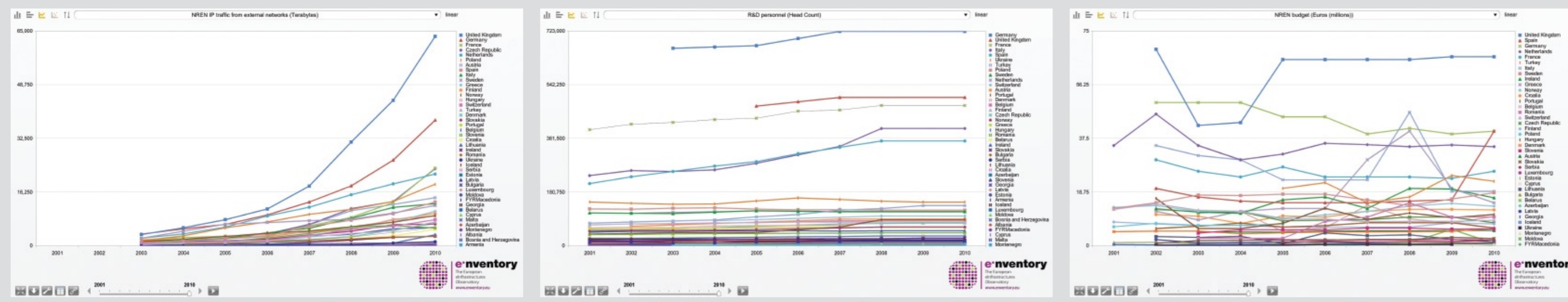
- Features a core set of more than **45 benchmarking indicators** as the baseline for monitoring e·Infrastructures' development progress, usage, impact and investments.

### The Research and Education Networking Timeline: a history of milestones



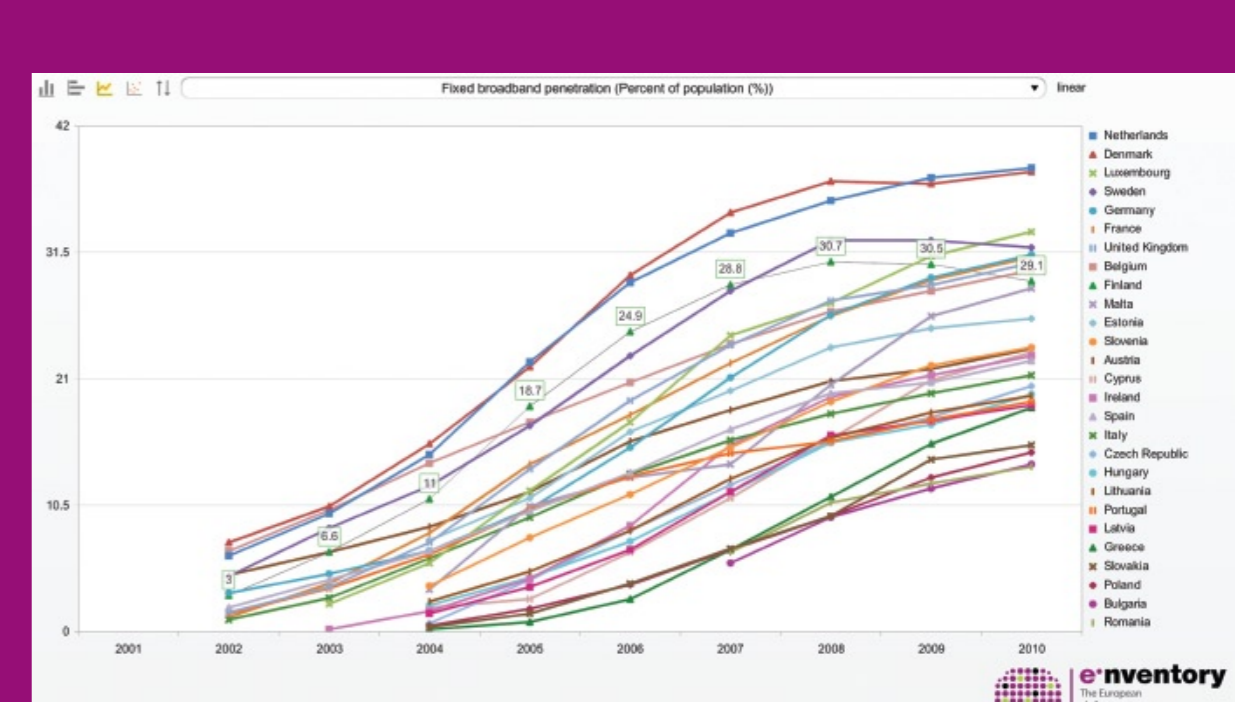
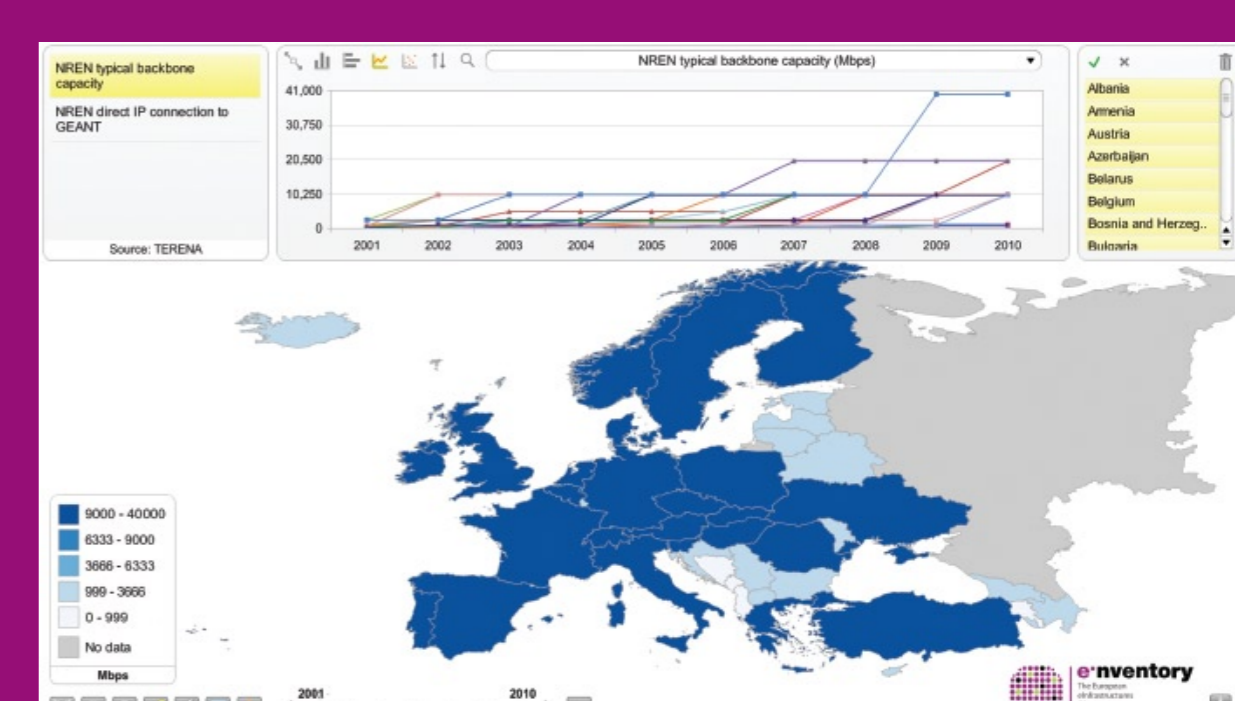
Left to right: Increasing needs (NREN IP traffic) vs. growth of R&D personnel vs. NREN budget
